

PROGRESS REPORT FOR THE PERIOD

JULY 2013 TO APRIL 2014

Nav Jyoti Manovikas Kendra is a school for special needs children. It is working for the welfare of children suffering from Autism, Mental Retardation, Cerebral Palsy and Multiple disabilities. We strongly believe that poverty and disability does not come in the way of realizing one's latent potential, what is required is proper access to education and opportunity. We have been working on mainstreaming the disabled child by providing them education, vocational training & employment opportunities depending on the level of their skill and ability. Over our long journey of 25 years, many children & their families have benefited through our efforts.

Navjyoti has emerged as a big hope for the disadvantaged child. We continue to identify & work for economically- socially deprived mentally challenged children with the aim to make them self reliant and lead healthy, dignified and sustainable quality of life.

The impact of our intervention is visible in children & families. It is gratifying to see them all changing for the better. There is lot more to be done for them and many more children to be brought into the ambit.

At present we are having 86 students who are taking benefit of educational vocational training along with extracurricular activities & therapeutic help. Every child in the school get regular training for learning functional academics (reading, writing, number concept, time & money concept, assessment of mass & volume), pre- vocational, vocational training, extracurricular activities like dancing, singing, sports, craft making etc according to the interest of the child.

Other than functional academics & vocational training, children undergo regular training for Art of Daily Living skills. Our children are also getting exposure for learning academics through Interactive Board.

Admission: Every new child brought for admission undergoes detailed examination & assessment by our experienced & qualified rehab professionals & special educators. After clinically examined by the clinical psychologist the child is referred to other specialist like physiotherapist if the person is having any neuromuscular deformity. Special educator conducts detailed evaluation of child's functional level. The placement of the child is finalized after reviewing all the reports of rehab professionals & special educator.

The criteria of distribution of the children in the classes is based on the basis of I Q scores & chronological age. Majority of our children in the school are distributed according to their mental ability & physical age. Each child's educational- programme is made on the basis of their I.Q. & functional ability. The distribution of children in each class is in the ration of 8 to 9 Maximum.

Our care group children in the school get regular training for self care beginning from toileting, brushing of teeth, taking of bath with the assistance of male & female attendants, eating food, washing hands & mouth.

School starts at 9:30 with the Morning Prayer, yoga, acupressure & P.T. After the Prayer, different groups of children perform different activities. At 10:30 A.M all children get back to their classes for academic work.

After the recess, every child gets exposure for the pre-vocation & vocation as per their interest, ability & skills, selection of pre vocation / vocation is finalize by the vocational instructors after observing the child & considering his/her aptitude, interest, level of intelligence, physical condition and type of disability our children get wider choice in selection of vocation. At present the following vocations are available.

1. **Chalk Making:** All older children male who joined the school in their later age form this group. They are engaged in making white and colored chalks under the supervision of vocational instructor. The final product is then supplied to various educational institutions as per their demand.

2. **Candle Making:** Educable group of boys & girls from this group. They make simple & designer candles, floating candles, jell candles with fragrance these candles are sold by our children with the assistance of vocational instructors fairs, school function's, exhibitions organized by various clubs, business houses and government agencies.

3. **Craft and Decorative Items:** Under this vocation children learn to make decorative items like greeting cards, bandanwars, and decorative envelopes.

4. **Canning & Furniture:** Some of our children receive training for doing canning work. We receive regular orders for repairing of chairs & furniture's.

5. **Tailoring:** Girls of educable group received training in tailoring (simple straight line machining), they also learn needle work & plain stitch, hemming, button fixing, hook & eye making etc.

6. **Broom Making:** We have started a new vocation of broom making from this session, under the supervision of the Instructor who is trained skilled worker. Our children are able to make 40-50 broom in a day these brooms are sold to the shop keepers, schools and individuals.

7. **Photocopy & Laminations:** Our new vocation of photocopy, lamination & spiral binding is working out well among our children. Our four to five children are under the training for learning this vocation.

8. **Art & Craft:** Children under this vocation learn to make flowers, garlands, rakhees, bandanwars, curtain hangings, artificial jewellery, friendship bands, photo frames, Kankan doras & pencil boxes.

9. **Kitchen Activities:** Educable group of girls who are self reliant, undergo this training program. In kitchen activities, girls get training for making beverages like tea, lemon squash, Roohafza, simple breakfast like poha, sandwich, upama, uttapam, maggi etc, They also get training for sorting, cleaning & cutting of vegetables, preparation of chappaties & Parathas.

Non educable group of girls get training for doing domestic work like cleaning, dusting, arranging of utensils & replacing utensils on the stand & keeping of kitchen accessories in proper place.

10. **Handicrafts & Painting Work:** Under this vocation children learn to make carry bags, greeting cards, decorative envelopes etc.

11. **Kitchen Garden & Gardening:** School children are also engaged in kitchen gardening, seasonal vegetables like spinach, brinjal, green chilies, lady finger, corn, cauliflower, beans, carrots, Bitter melon etc. are grown & consumed in the hostel kitchen. Other than vegetables, lemon, papaya, sitaphal etc. are also grown in the kitchen garden.

12. **Detergent Powder Making:** We have also started a new vocational venture of making detergent powder. Our vocational Instructor is training our children in this vocation. The quality of our detergent is very good which we supply at a nominal price, hence there is great demand for this product.

It may be pertinent to mention that we are going to start a full fledged vocational center very soon. A separate wing for this vocational center is being constructed with the aid to tune of Rs. 10, 00,000/- received from LIC Golden Jubilee Foundation.

“Interactive Audio Visual Smart Programme”

Training for functional academics is given to all the children in the educable group by using Interactive Audio Visual Board. In this programme, with the help of special software, overhead L.C.D Projector and Interactive Board the children are shown educational, interactive informative and entertaining programmes: They can also draw, paint & identify objects on Interactive Board with the help of Interactive Pen. This has revolutionized the teaching process in our Institute. Students are learning academics in a joyful manner & responding more promptly.

Along with educational & vocational training children get benefit of therapeutic treatment from the team of specialists who regularly attend these children. Institute is having a well equipped physiotherapy center & psychological lab where expert services are provided to the needy children. Our therapeutic team consists of acupressure specialist, clinical psychologist, physiotherapist, yoga Instructor, vocational teacher & trained special educators.

Extra Curricular Activities

Every child gets exposure for extracurricular activities along with educational & vocational training which includes- Dance, Music, Games- Sports, Picnics, educational excursions, visit to historical & religious places etc.
